Our 'contract'



We will show each other respect.



We will be kind to each other.



We must remember that some people can't read and can't tell the time.

They will need help with the menu.



We will make each other feel safe.



We will turn up on time.



We will all give each other the opportunity to speak.



We will give each other time to think.

It's fine if there is silence.



We won't use the words 'service user'. Instead we will use each others' names.

If we want to talk about the whole group we can use words like:
'Diners' or 'friends'



If someone tells us we have used wrong words we shouldn't feel bad about it.

It's a good way of learning what are good words to say.



It's fine to say if you don't want to answer a question.



If you're not sure about anything just ask.

We're all friends.



What happens at the meal stays at the meal!

We need to remember to keep things confidential.



If students want to talk about the project with other students they won't use names.
