Someone with a disability or autism on the organising committee

Separate tickets or wristbands for disabled/autistic attendees

Easy read information that includes times, locations, costs, how to get there and what to do about food and drink

Free tickets for carers/support workers

Quiet 'breakout' areas with subtle lighting

Seating areas and raised platforms - no stairs!

Accessible toilets that are regularly checked

A sign language or Makaton interpreter
