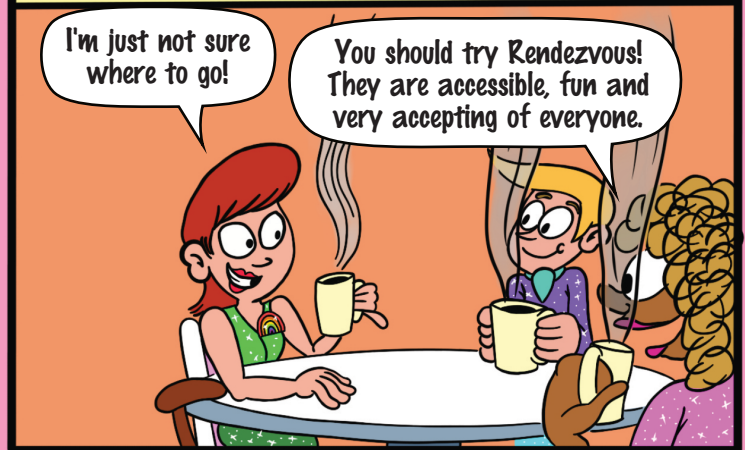


Sam is going on a night out to explore who she is and her community. She's feeling confident because she knows what to do for a fab safe night out.

Sam reads people's body language to see if they want to chat.

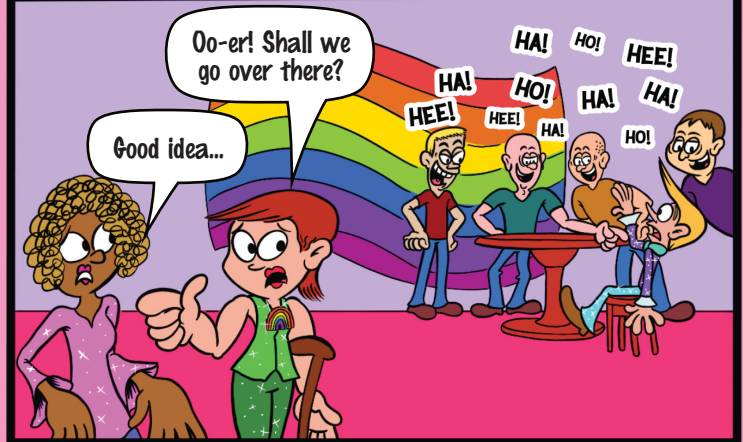


Let's dance!
